Murmliwasser.

Earth, sand and water are the key ingredients that make the 15,000-square-metre Murmliwasser so exciting and varied for children. Playful attractions include a marmot cave that visitors can explore, a golden panning area, diamond mine, huge sandpit, Sphere Tower with wooden balls and so much more! There's even a tunnel slide for extra fun for kids! Parents, who have accompanied their kids, can enjoy a pleasant time on the terrace of the Murmli Kiosk featuring relaxation zones. The Murmliwasser is only a 5-minute walk from the Komperdellbahn top station.

The Hög Adventure Park featuring the Schneisenfeger Family Coaster.

Everything at the Hög Adventure Park revolves around Alpine farming and forestry. There are numerous thrilling play stations for the entire family to enjoy including the Högsee lake with a shallow water area, bathing jetties and a sun island. Not to mention pedal-boat, raft- and kayak hire, here are many exciting details of the life of the hard-working bees to discover in the bee house. Meanwhile, the ride entrance for the Schneisenfeger Family Coaster is located in the Old Saw Mill. From there, passengers are transported up to the Alpkopf mountain past numerous interactive stations. Once at the top, guests race down the 1.5-km coaster track to the Högsee lake at speeds of up to 40 km/h.

Murmli Rodeo.

The Murmli Rodeo in the Murmliwasser features four play stops that demand not only speed but also dexterity and balance.

Serfauser Sauser.

Speeding over hikers at a height of 85 metres with speeds up to 65 km/h – that's exciting for sure! The Serfauser Sauser boarding is at the Sunliner top station. Our well trained guides will explain the process and help you fasten your safety harness. Then it's time to dip in, take a deep breath and here we go! From the Sunliner top station – in 4 sections – down to the Komperdellbahn valley station. Total length 2100 metres. Open daily 9am – 4.30pm.

Holzkugelweg.

Discover the Holzkugelweg (the wooden ball trail) – an unforgettable experience for the whole family! Starting just below the Alpkopfbahn mid station, the trail leads approximately 1.5 km down to the Komperdellbahn bottom station. The lovingly designed marble runs are a highlight for the kids, providing lots of fun and excitement. Here, little visitors can demonstrate their skills and guide their balls along the right path.

Six Senses trail.

In addition to our senses of sight, hearing, touch, smell and taste we can also experience illusions. Countless attractions delight walkers on the trail which is dotted with playful, quiz-like stops. Suitable for buggies. Walking time: approx. 4 hours.

Georama Lassida – Alpine family adventure at 2,350 m.

Just beside the Lassida restaurant, hobby researchers and discoverers can enter the world of geology and archaeology. Various fossils are hiding in the heart of Georama Lassida – in the huge sand excavation site. You can also find a Motor Skill Trail, relaxation stops "alpine garden" & "earth's crevice" as well as various interactive play stations in the so-called lab.

New: Rolling fun and a stunning panoramic view.

The "Georama Rundweg Lazid" is a themed walking path, 1.5 km long and accessible with baby buggies. The path combines geology, landscape and pleasure and entertains with various rolling tracks for playing with stone balls. Starting at the Lassida restaurant, you walk to the top station of Lawensbahn, stopping at some educational stations on the way as well as enjoying stunning panoramic views. The highlight is a large globe, which could be moved by stone balls and marks the end of the circular trail.

Lassida restaurant.

Situated right next to Lazidbahn top station at 2,350 m, enjoy the stunning panoramic views of the surrounding mountain scenery from the cosy lounge. Homemade wood-fired pizza, naturally homemade ice cream, and even the Georama Lassida await!

Sealm Hög restaurant.

Table-service restaurant in a prime location at the foot of the Högsee lake features an inviting sun and lounge-chair terrace. Traditional Tyrolean dishes, fish delicacies, vegetarian and vegan delicacies, homemade bread and ice cream are served!

Leithe Wirt restaurant.

This rustic table-service restaurant featuring a delightful sun terrace is situated right in the heart of the Serfaus hiking region and right next to the Komperdellbahn mid station. Tyrolean treats, naturally homemade ice cream and a spacious adventure playground invite guests to stop and enjoy. Hut brunch every Sunday. Reservations required.
